The 9th ICHRE will celebrate the 70th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the 25th anniversary of the education-oriented Vienna Declaration and cover a significant range of human rights education issues.

It will address HRE in national and international curricula, pedagogy and best practice, including in the context of discrimination faced by the First Nations, women, persons with disabilities, the LGBTIQ communities and those of refugee and minority cultural and religious backgrounds. Contemporary challenges to HRE and how to effectively address them will be considered.

Around 400 Australian and international delegates are expected to attend. They will include key human rights and education experts, advocates and grass-roots practitioners from developing countries, including the Asia-Pacific region, academics and government officials, and many others.

I am hopeful that the conference will advance community knowledge of human rights standards and will make a strong contribution to the development of human rights culture worldwide.
